- **26 May:** Meeting with Coordinators
- **End of May:** Finalisation of Papers



The "Rotterdam Process"

- **First day Plenary Session focusing on Issues Papers' subjects**
- **Interactive process between Plenary and Inter-Institutional Sessions**
- **Rotterdam Declaration to include key recommendations of Issues Papers**
- **Declaration as basis for follow-up action (political, technical, organisational, legal ..)**
- **COM Communication on TEN-T implementation: to include key recommendations**



Relation with Corridor Work Plans

- Facilitate the generation/start of relevant projects in the 2nd/ 3rd generation of corridor work plans
- Stimulate gradual and systematic coverage of all aspects of TEN-T infrastructure in further corridor work
- Advance the continuous integration of transport infrastructure and transport policy development
- Strengthen the focus of EU funding action, including the combination between CEF and other EU sources
