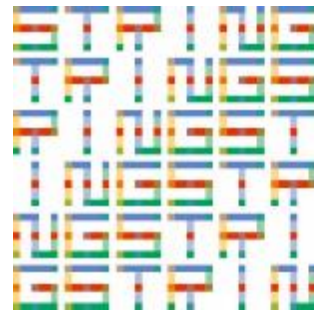

The Organisation: STRING is a political cross border partnership between Hamburg and Schleswig-Holstein in Germany, the Capital Region of Denmark, Region Zealand, and the City of Copenhagen in Denmark, and Region Skåne in Sweden.

The Region: STRING spans from the City of Hamburg across Schleswig-Holstein and the Danish islands of Lolland, Falster and Zealand, to Skåne in Sweden.

Activity 3. Implementation of pilot infrastructure. E-Mobility

- Expansion on current fast charge station coverage in the geographical area and enhancement of service levels to consumers
- Up to 50 QC in Sweden, up to 15 QC in Denmark and 5 in north Germany
- Increasing the number of customers driving electric vehicles in the geographical area



Activity 4. Implementation of pilot infrastructure. LNG/CNG Stations

- Three C-LNG stations
 - Stockholm - Expected EIO Q4 2017
 - Malmö - Expected EIO Q2 2018
 - Munkedal - Expected EIO Q2 2018
- Increasing the number of LNG trucks
- Validation of new IT-systems & biomethan mix

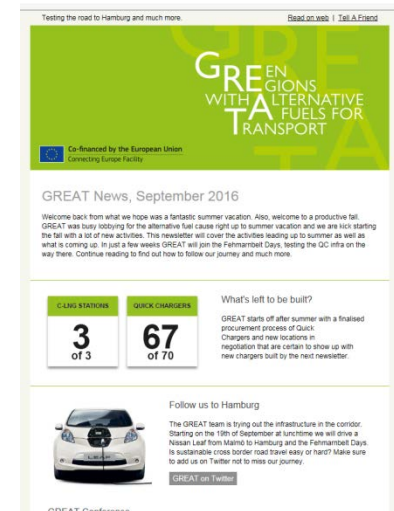
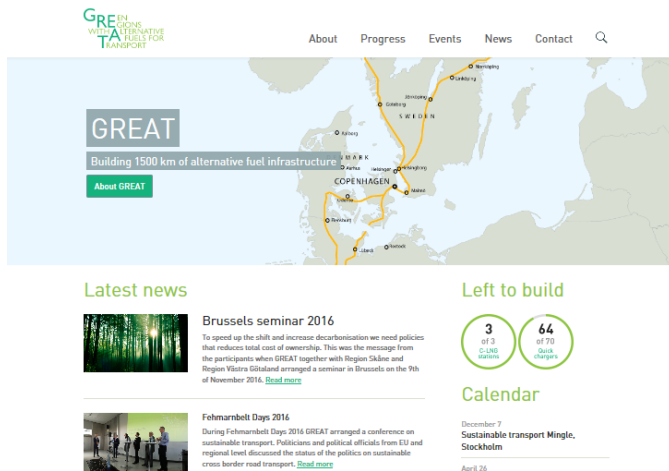
